Coca-Cola Christmas Truck Parade in Saint-Petersburg

Through the central streets of St. Petersburg will travel a caravan of bright Coca-Cola trucks decorated with lights glowing from the famous Coca-Cola advertising campaign, which will bring a real treat for adults and children!

Trucks will proceed along this route: Ploshad Pobedi – Moscovsky Prospect- Sennaya Ploshad- Gritsova pereulok – St. Isaac's Square – Proezd Dekabristov - English Embankment - Nevsky Prospect – Ploshad Vosstaniya - Ligovskiy - Rasstannaya street - Kamchatskaya street - Bukharestskaya street – Prospect Slavi - Tipanova Street - Moscow Square - Moskovsky Prospect – Ploshad Pobedi.
